

POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS: Minor Hand Surgery

CLINIC

GENERAL

1. Have a responsible adult with you for first twenty-four hours after surgery.
2. Do not drive a car or operate machinery for first twenty-four hours.
3. Do not drive a car after an arm or leg operation at least until the sutures are removed, and not at all with a plaster.
4. Do not make important decisions in the first twenty-four hours.

DRESSINGS AND WOUNDS

1. Leave all dressings intact for the first four days.
2. On day five take off bandage and wool, but leave sticky dressing on.
3. If sticky dressing becomes soiled or dirty it maybe replaced with another of the same type.
4. Keep wound and dressings dry (cover in plastic bag for shower) and keep arm elevated.

PAIN RELIEF

1. Initial pain maybe minimal due to the ongoing action of the local anaesthetic, but this will wear off after approximately eight hours. Therefore pain relief should be taken prior to going to bed on the first night post-operatively.
2. Take analgesia regularly, do not let pain get out of control.
3. You will receive a script for Panadeine Forte or a similar pain killer .

ACTIVITIES

1. Keep arm elevated above the level of the heart, either in or out of the sling
2. Move your shoulder and elbow three times a day to prevent stiffness
3. You may move your fingers and use your hand for light activities within pain limitations
4. Avoid heavy activities and avoid undue pressure or tension on the wound

PRECAUTIONS

1. Please call us if any of the following are worrying you
 - a. excessive bleeding or wound discharge
 - b. excessive swelling
 - c. excessive pain
 - d. severe fevers or chills
 - e. persistent tingling or numbness in the fingers after the first post operative day
 - f. if your stitches have burst or become excessively sore
